**Sub. S. B. No. 20 – Senator Hackett**

**Cosponsors: Senators Gardner, Uecker, Yuko, Wilson, Bacon, O'Brien**

To amend sections 2903.11, 2919.22, 2929.01, 2929.13, and 2929.14 and to enact section 2941.1425 of the Revised Code to require an additional prison term of 3 to 8 years for an offender who is convicted in specified circumstances of a felony offense of endangering children or felonious assault of a child if the offender also is convicted of a specification that the victim suffered permanent disabling harm and to name the act "Destiny's Law."

(Committee on Judiciary recommends passage of substitute bill March 22, 2017)

**Am. S. B. No. 32 – Senator Eklund**

**Cosponsors: Senators Coley, Hoagland, Bacon, O'Brien**

To amend sections 2945.71 and 2945.73 of the Revised Code to provide a prosecutor an additional fourteen days to commence a trial after a person charged with a felony has been discharged because the person has not been brought to trial within the required amount of time and to authorize the court to release the person from detention in connection with those charges pending trial.

To amend sections 2913.04 and 2923.129 and to enact section 5503.101 of the Revised Code to allow disclosure of information from the law enforcement automated data system (LEADS) to a defendant in a traffic or criminal case.

**S. B. No. 62 – Senator Yuko**

To enact section 5.236 of the Revised Code to designate July 8 as "Harrison Dillard Day."

**S. B. No. 88 – Senator Terhar**

To amend sections 118.05, 118.06, 118.11, 118.12, 118.13, and 118.99 and to repeal the version of section 118.023 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect September 29, 2017, to modify the composition and powers of the financial planning and supervision commission of a political subdivision that is in a state of fiscal emergency and to clarify the duties of that political subdivision.

To amend section 3772.99 of the Revised Code to specify that the criminal penalty related to casino operators and employees participating in casino gaming applies at their casino facility or an affiliated casino facility.
