

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes**

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present or checked in.

Senator Eklund moved that the minutes of the previous meeting be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Manning seconded the motion. The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was an Attorney General's appointment to committee - Public Utilities. The report was properly signed.

The second order of business was Governor's appointments to committees - Health, Human Services and Medicaid - Finance - Insurance and Financial Institutions - Transportation, Commerce and Workforce. All the reports were properly signed.

The third order of business was the Advise and Consent Report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Gardner moved the report, seconded by Senator Huffman. The Advise and Consent Report was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0 and the report was properly signed.

The fourth order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, March 29, 2017:

The Chair called up H.B. No. 9 (Koehler)--Limit scope of protocol for malfunctioning traffic signals.

Senator Hite moved H.B. No. 9, seconded by Senator Thomas. H.B. No. 9 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 1 (LaRose)--Revise drug laws.

Senator Burke moved S.B. No. 1, seconded by Senator Coley. S.B. No. 1 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Gardner moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator Coley seconded the motion.
