

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes
September 20, 2017
132nd General Assembly

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present or checked in.

The Chair asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the previous meeting. Senator Coley moved, seconded by Senator Huffman. There being no objections, the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was the appointments by the Governor to committees: Agriculture - Education - Energy and Natural Resources - Finance - Government Oversight and Reform - Health, Human Services and Medicaid - Judiciary - Local Government, Public Safety and Veterans Affairs - Public Utilities - Transportation, Commerce and Workforce. The appointments were sent to committees and the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was an appointment by the Attorney General to committee: Public Utilities. The appointment was sent to committee and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, September 20, 2017. Senator Eklund moved that the report be referred without changes or corrections. Senator Yuko seconded the motion. The Reference Report for Wednesday, September 20, 2017 was referred to the floor without changes or corrections and the report was properly signed.

The fourth order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, September 20, 2017:

The Chair called up S.R. No. 175 (Bacon/Kunze) To express support for the Hyperloop Transportation Initiative.
Senator Thomas moved S.R. No. 175, seconded by Senator Burke. S.R. No. 175 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 59 (Leland/West) Designate Moses Fleetwood Walker Day.
Senator Brown moved H.B. No. 59, seconded by Senator Gardner. H.B. No. 59 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 163 (Wilson) Modify qualifications for investing county inactive moneys.
Senator Hite moved S.B. No. 163, seconded by Senator Thomas. S.B. No. 163 was referred to the floor by a vote of 14-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Peterson moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator Eklund seconded the motion.
