

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes**  
**October 11, 2017**  
**132nd General Assembly**

Chairman Obhof called the meeting to order.  
Attendance was taken. A quorum was present or checked in.

The Chair asked for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Huffman moved that the minutes of the previous meeting be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Burke seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was the reports of appointments by the Governor to committees: Agriculture - Finance - Government Oversight and Reform - Health, Human Services and Medicaid - Judiciary - Insurance and Financial Institutions - Transportation, Commerce and Workforce. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Yuko moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Hite seconded the motion. The Advise and Consent report was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Advise and Consent report for the Governor's appointment of Michael Gonidakis. Senator Eklund moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Coley seconded the motion. The Advise and Consent report for the Governor's appointment of Michael Gonidakis was referred to the floor by a vote of 10-3 (Senators Brown, Tavares and Yuko voting no) and the report was properly signed.

The fourth order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, October 11, 2017:

The Chair called up H.B. No. 31 (Cupp) Abolish Government Contracting Advisory Council. Senator Coley moved H.B. No. 31, seconded by Senator Manning. H.B. No. 31 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

The Chair called up H.B. No. 94 (Sykes/Perales) Designate Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month. Senator Brown moved H.B. No. 94, seconded by Senator Gardner. H.B. No. 94 was referred to the floor by a vote of 13-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Peterson moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator Burke seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
