

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Rules and Reference Minutes**  
**October 25, 2017**  
**132nd General Assembly**

Chair Obhof called the meeting to order.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present or checked in.

The Chair asked for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Senator Huffman moved that the minutes of the previous meeting be accepted without changes or corrections. Senator Tavares seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted without changes or corrections.

The first order of business was the reports of appointments by the Governor to committees: Energy and Natural Resources - Finance - Government Oversight and Reform - Health, Human Services and Medicaid - Insurance and Financial Institutions - Transportation, Commerce and Workforce. All the reports were properly signed.

The second order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Governor. Senator Eklund moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Thomas seconded the motion. The Advise and Consent report was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0 and the report was properly signed.

The third order of business was the Advise and Consent report of appointments by the Attorney General. Senator Manning moved that the report be referred to the floor. The fourth order of business was the Reference Report for Wednesday, October 25, 2017. Senator Gardner moved that the report be referred to the floor. Senator Coley seconded the motion. The fifth order of business was the calendar for Wednesday, October 25, 2017:

The Chair called up H.B. No. 118 (Merrin) Prohibit dismissing tax complaint if fails to identify owner.

Senator Oelslager moved H.B. No. 118, seconded by Senator Huffman. H.B. No. 118 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 127 (LaRose) Require actions when driver approaches waste collection vehicle.

Senator Burke moved S.B. No. 127, seconded by Senator Thomas. S.B. No. 127 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

The Chair called up S.B. No. 139 (Skindell/Eklund) Adopt Uniform Electronic Legal Material Act. Senator Tavares moved S.B. No. 139, seconded by Senator Brown. S.B. No. 139 was referred to the floor by a vote of 12-0.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Senator Thomas moved that the meeting be adjourned. Senator Eklund seconded the motion. Hearing no objections, Chairman Obhof adjourned the meeting.
