CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Harry Meshel Memorial Highway" ¹	The portion of the road known as U.S. Route 422, running in a northwesterly and southeasterly direction, between the intersections of U.S. Route 62 and 5th Avenue, in the municipal corporation of Youngstown.

Harry Meshel, a former Ohio Senate president and state Democratic Party chairman, passed away on September 4, 2017. He served as an Ohio Senator for over 22 years and was an active leader in politics and the Youngstown community.
