### **BILL SUMMARY**

- Prohibits a person from manufacturing, selling, or transferring any device that accelerates the rate of fire of a semi-automatic firearm without converting it into an automatic firearm.
  - Makes a violation of the prohibition a second degree felony.

### **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

#### **Manufacture or transfer of a rate-of-fire acceleration product**

The bill creates the offense of "manufacture or transfer of a rate-of-fire acceleration product." The bill prohibits a person from manufacturing, selling, or transferring a trigger crank, a bump-fire device, or any part, combination of parts, component, device, attachment, or accessory that is designed or functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semi-automatic firearm without converting it into an automatic firearm.<sup>1</sup>

#### **Criminal penalty for violation**

A violation of manufacture or transfer of a rate-of-fire acceleration product is a second degree felony.<sup>2</sup>
