CONTENT AND OPERATION

"Girls on the Run" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:¹

Special License Plate	Girls on the Run license plate, inscribed with identifying words or markings selected by representatives of the Girls on the Run of Franklin County, Inc. that are approved by the Registrar.
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
Contribution and Additional BMV Fee	\$20 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
Use of Contribution	Girls on the Run of Franklin County, Inc. must use the contributions to support the activities of the organization. ²
Requirements for Issuance	(1) Submission of an application; (2) Payment of the regular license tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable local tax, any applicable special reserved license plate fee; and (3) Compliance with all other applicable laws relating to

	motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
