## Fiscal Note & Local Impact Statement

**Bill:** H.B. 573 of the 132nd G.A.

**Subject:** Designates the Henry County Veterans Highway

---

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur about \$350 to \$400 in costs for producing and installing a set of memorial signs for this memorial highway. Specifically, the bill designates the stretch of U.S. Route 24 between the eastern and western borders of Henry County as the Henry County Veterans Highway. When a portion of a U.S. route is designated as a memorial highway, ODOT produces and installs the signs. Two signs are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
