**Sec. 155.99.** (A) Whoever violates division (B) of section 155.04 of the Revised Code is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. 27

(B) Whoever violates section 155.05 of the Revised Code is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. 29

(C) Whoever violates division (B) (1) of section 155.28 of  
the Revised Code is guilty of a misdemeanor. Notwithstanding  
sections 2929.21 to 2929.28 of the Revised Code, the court shall  
order the offender to pay any money received from selling or  
otherwise disposing of a war relic to the veterans service  
commission of the county in which the war relic was located. 31

(D) Whoever violates division (B) (2) of section 155.28 of  
the Revised Code is guilty of a misdemeanor. Notwithstanding  
sections 2929.21 to 2929.28 of the Revised Code, the court may  
order the offender to pay a fine of not more than ten thousand  
dollars to the veterans service commission of the county in 37

(E) Whoever violates division (B) (3) of section 155.28 of 44  
the Revised Code is guilty of a misdemeanor. Notwithstanding 45

institute a right to cure period of ninety days to restore the 47  
war relic to its prior condition and location. Upon the 48  
expiration of the right to cure period, the court may order an 49  
offender who has not cured the violation to pay a fine of not 50  
more than ten thousand dollars to the veterans service 51  
commission of the county in which the war relic was located." 52
