11 SYNOPSIS

12 **Ohio political party fund income tax checkoff**

13 **Section 757.240**

14 Accelerates the application date of a provision added by
15 the Senate that eliminates the political party fund income tax
16 checkoff. The Senate-passed bill eliminates the checkoff for
17 taxable years beginning after 2019. The amendment eliminates the
18 checkoff immediately (for taxable years beginning after 2018,
19 generally meaning returns filed in 2020).

20 Under current law, taxpayers may opt to credit \$1 of their
21 income tax liability to the fund. Married couples filing joint
22 returns may credit up to \$2. Money in the fund is divided among
23 the state's major political parties.

26 Decreases FID appropriation line item 110613, Ohio
