SYNOPSIS

20 **Peer-to-peer car sharing: Registration, data sharing,**
21 **Attorney General oversight, and effective date**

25 **Data sharing**

26 Eliminates the Senate provision that requires the records
27 collected by a peer-to-peer car sharing program pertaining to a
28 shared vehicle to be provided on request to law enforcement in
29 all circumstances.

30 Instead requires the program to cooperate with a shared
31 vehicle owner, shared vehicle driver, or any insurer when any
32 reasonable request for the records is made for facilitating the
33 investigation of a claim or accident, and requires the program
34 to provide the records to law enforcement upon receipt of a
35 warrant. (The amendment does not *prohibit* the program from
36 providing records to law enforcement without a warrant.)

37 **Attorney General oversight**

38 Removes a Senate-added provision that does both of the
39 following:

40 1. Specifies that any violation of the bill's requirements
41 governing peer-to-peer car sharing is an unfair and deceptive
42 act in violation of the Consumer Sales Practices Act (CSPA);

43 2. Grants the Attorney General (AG) clear and primary
44 enforcement authority over such a violation.

45 (The amendment retains a provision specifying that peer-to-
46 peer car sharing and a peer-to-peer car sharing agreement are
47 consumer transactions for purposes of the CSPA. Thus, whether a
48 violation of the peer-to-peer car sharing provisions is a
49 violation of the CSPA, and enforceable by the AG, would depend
50 on the circumstances of the violation.)

51 **Effective date**

52 Makes the peer-to-peer car sharing provisions effective an
53 additional 90 days after the bill's effective date.
