22 **Department of Higher Education**23 **Sections 381.10 and 381.373**

24 Increases GRF appropriation item 235591, Co-op Internship
25 Program, by \$612,500 in FY 2020 and \$812,500 in FY 2021 and
26 makes the following changes to several earmarks:

27 (1) Increases, from \$50,000 in each fiscal year to \$612,500
28 in FY 2020 and \$812,500 in FY 2021, the earmark to support the
29 operations of Ohio University's Voinovich School, effectively
30 restoring the earmark to the House-passed version of the bill;

31 (2) Increases, from \$50,000 to \$62,500 in each fiscal year,
32 the earmark to support the Ohio State University's John Glenn
33 College of Public Affairs, effectively restoring the earmark to
34 the House-passed version of the bill;

35 (3) Increases, from \$50,000 to \$62,500 in each fiscal year,
36 the earmark to support the Bliss Institute of Applied Politics
37 at the University of Akron, effectively restoring the earmark to
38 the House-passed version of the bill;

39 (4) Decreases, from \$150,000 to \$100,000 in each fiscal
40 year, the earmark to support students who attend institutions of
41 higher education in Ohio and are participating in the Washington
42 Center Internship Program, effectively restoring the earmark to
43 the House-passed version of the bill;

44 (5) Adds its Model United Nations Program and increases,
45 from \$50,000 to \$75,000 in each fiscal year, the earmark to
46 support the operations of the Center for Liberal Arts Student
47 Success at Wright State University; and

48 (6) Earmarks \$50,000 in each fiscal year to support the
49 Kent State University Washington Program in National Issues.
