After line 389, insert: 3

"**Sec. 101.38.** (A) As used in this section, "relative" means a 4  
spouse, parent, parent-in-law, sibling, sibling-in-law, child, 5  
child-in-law, grandparent, aunt, or uncle. 6

(B) There is hereby created the Ohio cystic fibrosis 7  
legislative task force to study and make recommendations on issues 8  
pertaining to the care and treatment of individuals with cystic 9  
fibrosis. The task force shall study and make recommendations on 10  
the following issues: 11

(1) Use of prescription drug and innovative therapies under 12  
the program for medically handicapped children established under 13  
section 3701.023 of the Revised Code and the program for adults 14  
with cystic fibrosis administered by the department of health 15  
under division (G) of that section; 16

(2) Screening of newborn children for the presence of genetic 17  
disorders, as required under section 3701.501 of the Revised Code; 18

- (3) Any other issues the task force considers appropriate. 19
- (C) The task force shall consist of the following members, 20  
each with the authority to vote on matters before the task force: 21
- (1) Three members of the senate: two appointed by the 22  
president of the senate from the majority party and one appointed 23  
by the minority leader of the senate; 24
- (2) Three members of the house of representatives: two 25  
appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives from the 26  
majority party and one appointed by the minority leader of the 27  
house of representatives; 28
- (3) Three members, at least two of whom have been diagnosed 29  
with cystic fibrosis or are relatives of individuals who have been 30  
diagnosed with cystic fibrosis, appointed by the president of the 31  
senate; 32
- (4) Three members, at least two of whom have been diagnosed 33  
with cystic fibrosis or are relatives of individuals who have been 34  
diagnosed with cystic fibrosis, appointed by the speaker of the 35  
house of representatives. 36
- ~~Initial members shall be appointed not later than sixty days~~ 37  
~~after the effective date of this section. Appointments to the task~~ 38  
~~force shall be made within forty-five days after the commencement~~ 39  
~~of the first regular session of each general assembly in the~~ 40  
~~manner prescribed in this division.~~ 41
- (D) ~~Each member~~ Members of the task force shall serve a 42  
~~one-year term that ends on the same day of the same month as did~~ 43  
~~the term that it succeeds. Members may be reappointed on the task~~ 44  
~~force until the appointments are made in the first regular session~~ 45  
~~of the following general assembly or, in the case of task force~~ 46  
~~members who also are general assembly members when appointed,~~ 47

until they are no longer general assembly members. 48

(E) A vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the 49  
original appointment. Any member appointed to fill a vacancy 50  
occurring prior to the expiration date of the term for which the 51  
member's predecessor was appointed shall hold office as a member 52  
for the remainder of that term. 53

~~A member shall continue in office subsequent to the 54  
expiration date of the member's term until a successor takes 55  
office or until a period of sixty days has elapsed, whichever 56  
occurs first.~~ 57

(F) Members of the task force shall elect a chair ~~to serve a 58  
term of one year.~~ A vacancy of the chair position shall be filled 59  
by election. 60

(G) Members of the task force shall receive no compensation, 61  
except to the extent that serving as a member is part of the 62  
individual's regular duties of employment and except for the 63  
reimbursement of expenses that may be provided under division (H) 64  
of this section. 65

(H) The task force may solicit and accept grants from public 66  
and private sources. Grant funds may be used to reimburse members 67  
for expenses incurred in the performance of official task force 68  
duties and to pursue initiatives pertaining to the care and 69  
treatment of individuals with cystic fibrosis. 70

(I) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a 71  
quorum for the conduct of task force meetings." 72

SYNOPSIS

**Cystic Fibrosis Legislative Task Force** 74

**R.C. 101.38** 75

Reinstates and modifies the House-added provision that does 76  
all of the following: 77

Requires appointment of members to the Cystic Fibrosis 78  
Legislative Task Force to occur within 45 days (from 15 in the 79  
House-added provisions) following the first regular session of 80  
each General Assembly. 81

Eliminates the limitation that the chairperson of the Task 82  
Force may only serve as chairperson for one year. 83

Provides that a member of the Task Force who is also a member 84  
of the General Assembly serves as a member of the Task Force until 85  
no longer a member of the General Assembly. 86
