R.C. 3301.0712

21 Clarifies that the Department of Education must seek a
22 waiver from the U.S. Secretary of Education in order to make the
23 Algebra I end-of-course exam the primary high school math
24 assessment, rather than requiring the Department to seek a
25 waiver from any geometry assessment requirement under federal
26 law as under the Senate version of the bill.

27 Requires the Superintendent of Public Instruction, or
28 designee, to conduct a public presentation before the House and
29 Senate education committees that consider primary and secondary
30 legislation regarding the range of scores on the end-of-course
31 exams designated by the State Board of Education, rather than
32 requiring the State Board to consult with those committees prior
33 to determining and designating scores as under the Senate
34 version of the bill.
