Ohio Cyber Reserve 35

R.C. 5922.01, 5922.02, 5922.03, 5922.04, 5922.05, 5922.06, 36

5922.07, 5922.08, 5923.01, 5923.03, 5923.12, 5923.37, and 5924.01; 37
 Sections 205.10 and 205.20 38

Removes the following Senate provisions: 39

Requires the Governor to organize and maintain state civilian 40
 cyber security reserve forces, to be known as the Ohio Cyber 41
 Reserve, to protect government, critical infrastructure, 42
 businesses, and citizens from cyber attacks. 43

Makes the Reserve part of, and Reserve members civilian 44
 volunteers for, the Ohio organized militia under the Adjutant 45
 General's department. 46

Permits the Reserve to become a civilian component of the 47
 Ohio National Guard, but does not authorize the Reserve to be 48
 called into national military service. 49

Prescribes eligibility and administrative requirements for 50
 the Reserve. 51

Treats Reserve members on state active duty similarly to 52
 other members of the Ohio organized militia. 53

Requires the Adjutant General to establish Reserve members' 54
 rates of pay in state active duty and requires Reserve members to 55
 serve in unpaid volunteer status while training. 56

Specifies procedures for the Governor to remove Reserve 57
 members. 58

Allows the Governor to adopt rules governing the Reserve, and 59
 requires a copy of the rules to be publicly available in the 60
 Adjutant General's office. 61

Permits the Governor, for Reserve use, to requisition 63
 equipment from the U.S. Department of Defense and make available 64

state armory facilities, equipment, and other premises and property.	65 66
Specifies that members of the Reserve are entitled to the same liability protections as members of the Ohio organized militia.	67 68 69
Creates GRF line item 745503, Ohio Cyber Reserve, with an appropriation of \$100,000 in FY 2020 and \$550,000 in FY 2021, and earmarks those amounts in each fiscal year for the Adjutant General's Department to operate the Ohio Cyber Reserve.	70 71 72 73

Requires a board of elections to audit the official results	97
of every general election and of every primary election held in an	98
even-numbered year.	99
Provides the minimum requirements and a timeline for the	100
audit, and requires the Secretary of State to prescribe certain	101
procedures for the audit.	102
Specifies that the audit must use a risk-limiting audit	103
protocol, a percentage-based audit protocol, or another protocol	104
approved by the Secretary, and allows the Secretary to either	105
choose the protocol the boards must use or permit the boards to	106
choose a protocol.	107
Requires the audit to be open to observers appointed under	108
the Election Law.	109
