33 SYNOPSIS

34 **Transcranial magnetic stimulation pilot program**

35 **R.C. 5902.09**

36 Revises the Senate provision that required the Directors of
37 Veterans Services and Mental Health and Addiction Services to
38 establish a pilot program to make transcranial magnetic
39 stimulation available for veterans with substance use disorders
40 or mental illness, and to contract with AMVETS for services
41 related to the program. The amendment instead requires the
42 Directors to select a supplier for the services under state law
43 that regulates the purchase of supplies and services, which
44 requires competitive selection for services that cost \$50,000 or
45 more.

46 Adds a requirement that requires the approval of
47 Controlling Board before money is disbursed under the program.

49 **Sections 337.10 and 337.230**

50 Creates DPF Fund 5VV0 line item 336645, Transcranial
51 Magnetic Stimulation Pilot, with an appropriation of \$3.0
52 million in each fiscal year. Earmarks these funds to be used for
53 a transcranial magnetic stimulation pilot program for veterans
54 with substance use disorders and mental illness as described in
55 section 5902.09 of the Revised Code.
