"**Sec. 124.132.** A state employee who is a certified disaster 4  
service volunteer of the American red cross or who is a verified 5  
team rubicon volunteer may be granted leave from ~~his~~ work with pay 6  
for not to exceed thirty work days in each year to participate in 7  
specialized disaster relief services ~~for the American red cross,~~ 8  
upon the request of the American red cross or of team rubicon for 9  
the services of that employee and upon the approval of that 10  
employee's appointing authority. The appointing authority shall 11  
compensate an employee granted leave under this section at ~~his~~ the 12  
employee's regular rate of pay for those regular work hours during 13  
which the employee is absent from ~~his~~ work." 14

SYNOPSIS

**State employee leave for Team Rubicon** 16

**R.C. 124.132** 17

Reinstates a House provision removed by the Senate. It does 18  
the following: 19

Authorizes a state employee's appointing authority to grant 20  
the employee leave with pay for not to exceed 30 work days in each 21  
year to participate in specialized disaster relief services for 22  
Team Rubicon, upon the request of Team Rubicon for the services of 23  
that employee, and requires the appointing authority to compensate 24  
the employee at the employee's regular rate of pay for those 25  
regular work hours during which the employee is absent from work. 26  
Under continuing law, a state employee who is a certified disaster 27  
service volunteer of the American Red Cross is eligible for leave 28  
under the same criteria as provided in the bill for volunteers of 29  
Team Rubicon. 30
