24 **Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services**

25 **Sections 337.10, 337.220, 512.20, and 513.10**

26 Increases the appropriation to DPF Fund 4750 line item
27 336623, Statewide Treatment and Prevention, by \$31.0 million in
28 FY 2020 and \$5.0 million in FY 2021 and uses these funds to
29 restore the following Executive earmarks: (1) \$18.0 million in
30 FY 2020 for K-12 prevention education initiatives; and (2)
31 \$13.0 million in FY 2020 and \$5.0 million FY 2021 for statewide
32 multimedia prevention, treatment, and stigma reduction
33 campaigns.

34 Restores the following Executive provisions that transfer
35 funds to Fund 4750 to support this increase: \$31.0 million from
36 the FY 2019 GRF ending balance; and \$5.0 million in FY 2021 from
37 the GRF.
