**Sports gaming equipment** 26

**R.C. 3770.30 and 3770.331** 27

Clarifies that a vendor who provides sports gaming 28  
equipment to be used through a licensed sports gaming agent is 29  
not considered a sports gaming agent solely on that basis. 30

Specifies that the State Lottery Commission may provide by 31  
rule for the Commission to supply some or all of the sports 32  
gaming equipment to be used by veteran's or fraternal 33  
organizations under the bill through a vendor selected by the 34  
Commission. 35
