6 affiliate or subsidiary to any of the following:

7        (a) Any police officer appointed under division (D)(1) of

10 nonprofit hospital agency that applied for the appointment of  
11 any police officer under division (D)(1) of this section, or any  
12 affiliate or subsidiary of the hospital;

16 affiliate or subsidiary of the hospital;

24 **Hospital police and security officers**

25 **R.C. 4973.17**

26 Provides that nothing in the provision granting immunity to  
27 a municipal corporation where a hospital is located or county in  
28 the unincorporated territory of which a hospital is located is  
29 to be construed as granting immunity for actions occurring on  
30 the hospital premises or its affiliate's or subsidiary's  
31 premises to any of the following: (a) a police officer appointed  
32 by the Secretary of State; (b) a hospital that applied for such  
33 appointment of a police officer; (c) any other police or  
34 security officer providing services to the hospital; or (d) any  
35 entity that provides the services of police or security officers  
36 to a hospital.
