Instead of publishing an abstract of a county agricultural 54
 society's treasurer's account in a newspaper of general 55
 circulation in the county, requires a county agricultural 56
 society to publish an announcement in either a newspaper of 57
 general circulation in the county or on the society's web site 58
 for not less than two weeks that contains all of the following: 59

-- A statement indicating that the annual financial report 60

-- A statement indicating that any person who wishes to 62
