"(E) Notwithstanding such Executive Order, section 3701.13	2
of the Revised Code, or any other provision of law to the	3
contrary, any amusement park or water park in this state that	4
operates amusement rides as defined in section 993.01 of the	5
Revised Code may open and begin operation beginning on the	6
effective date of this section. The Director of Agriculture, in	7
consultation with the Director of Health, shall establish	8
standards and guidelines to limit the spread of infectious	9
disease at such amusement parks and water parks. The owners of	10
an amusement park and the owners of a water park shall ensure	11
compliance with the standards and guidelines."	12
