BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4743.05 be amended and sections	6
4741.50, 4741.51, 4741.52, 4741.53, 4741.54, 4741.55, 4741.56,	7
and 4741.57 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 4741.50. (A) As used in sections 4741.50 to 4741.56	9
of the Revised Code:	10
(1) "Educational expenses" means all of the following	11
expenses that were incurred while a veterinarian was enrolled,	12
for a maximum of four years, in a veterinary college that,	13
during the time of enrollment, was approved by the state	14
veterinary medical licensing board or accredited by the American	15
veterinary medical association:	16
(a) Tuition:	1 7



(b) Other educational expenses, such as fees, books, and	18
laboratory expenses, for specific purposes and in amounts	19
determined to be reasonable by the board;	20
(c) Room and board, in an amount determined to be	21
reasonable by the board.	22
(2) "Educational loan" includes the principal and interest	23
of a government or other educational loan used to pay	24
educational expenses.	25
(B) There is hereby created the veterinarian student debt	26
assistance program. Under the program, the state veterinary	27
medical licensing board, by means of a contract entered into	28
under section 4741.54 of the Revised Code, may agree to repay	29
all or part of any educational loans taken out by a veterinarian	30
for educational expenses. The board shall operate the program in	31
accordance with sections 4741.50 to 4741.57 of the Revised Code.	32
Sec. 4741.51. (A) The state veterinary medical licensing	33
board, in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code,	34
shall adopt rules necessary to implement and administer the	35
veterinarian student debt assistance program.	36
(B) Rules adopted under division (A) of this section shall	37
do all of the following:	38
(1) Provide for the development of a lottery system for	39
selecting who, from the list of eligible veterinarians, will	40
receive veterinarian student debt assistance;	41
(2) Provide for a method to determine the amount that each	42
recipient of veterinarian student debt assistance receives if	43
selected through the lottery system. The rules shall require	44
that, each calendar year, all recipients receive the same amount	45
of assistance. That amount shall be between five thousand and	46

ten thousand dollars per recipient.	47
(3) Establish the types of charitable veterinarian	48
services that qualify for application to and participation in	49
the program, including, but not limited to, spay and neutering	50
services;	51
(4) Establish the minimum amount of time that a	52
veterinarian must have performed charitable veterinarian	53
services to be eligible to apply to the program. The number of	54
hours shall be not less than twelve.	5.5
(5) Establish the minimum period of time, not to exceed	56
two years, that a veterinarian must agree to reside in this	57
state under a contract entered into under section 4741.54 of the	58
Revised Code;	59
(6) Provide for the inclusion of information regarding the	60
program on application forms for both an initial veterinary	61
license and a renewal of a veterinary license;	62
(7) Establish any other procedures and requirements that	63
the board determines is necessary to administer and implement	64
the program.	65
Sec. 4741.52. (A) A veterinarian who meets all of the	66
following requirements is eligible to apply for participation in	67
the veterinarian student debt assistance program:	68
(1) The veterinarian is a citizen of the United States, a	69
national of the United States, or a permanent resident of the	70
United States.	71
(2) The veterinarian is licensed under this chapter and	72
has been engaged in the practice or instruction of veterinary	73
medicine in this state for more than six months prior to	7.4

submitting an application for veterinarian student debt	75
assistance.	76
(3) The veterinarian has taken out an educational loan.	77
(4) The educational loan was used for educational expenses	78
that were incurred while the veterinarian was enrolled in a	79
veterinary college.	80
(5) The veterinarian has performed charitable veterinarian	81
services in accordance with rules adopted under section 4741.51	82
of the Revised Code.	83
(6) The veterinarian is not a member of the state	84
veterinary medical licensing board at the time the application	85
is submitted under division (B) of this section.	86
(7) The veterinarian is not an active participant in the	87
veterinary student debt assistance program.	88
(B) A veterinarian shall submit an application for	89
participation in the veterinarian student debt assistance	90
program to the state veterinary medical licensing board on a	91
form that the board prescribes. The veterinarian shall submit	92
the following information with an application:	93
(1) The veterinarian's name, permanent address or address	94
at which the veterinarian is currently residing if different	95
from the permanent address, and telephone number;	96
(2) The veterinary college the veterinarian attended and	97
the dates of attendance;	98
(3) A summary and verification of the educational expenses	99
for which the veterinarian seeks reimbursement under the	100
program;	101

(4) Verification of the veterinarian's authorization under	102
this chapter to practice veterinary medicine;	103
(5) Verification that the veterinarian is a citizen of the	104
United States, a national of the United States, or a permanent	105
resident of the United States;	106
(6) A statement attesting that the veterinarian performed	107
charitable veterinarian services in accordance with rules	108
adopted under section 4741.51 of the Revised Code;	109
(7) Any other information the board determines is	110
necessary and appropriate.	111
Sec. 4741.53. (A) If the veterinarian student debt	112
assistance fund created in section 4741.56 of the Revised Code	113
contains sufficient money and the general assembly has	114
appropriated funds for the veterinarian student debt assistance	115
program, the state veterinary medical licensing board may	116
approve a veterinarian for participation in the program if the	117
board finds that the veterinarian is eligible for participation	118
in the program. By the first day of June each year, the board	119
shall compile a list of all eligible veterinarians.	120
(B) The state veterinary medical licensing board shall	121
select eligible veterinarians to receive veterinarian student	122
debt assistance in accordance with the lottery system	123
established in rules adopted under section 4741.51 of the	124
Revised Code.	125
(C) Upon selection of a veterinarian, the board shall	126
notify and enter into discussions with the veterinarian. The	127
object of the discussions is to determine if the veterinarian	128
agrees to do both of the following:	129
(1) Perform charitable veterinarian services in this state	130

in an amount and for a duration of time established in rules	131
adopted under section 4741.51 of the Revised Code;	132
(2) Reside in this state for a minimum duration of time	133
established in rules adopted under section 4741.51 of the	134
Revised Code after the receipt of veterinarian student debt	135
assistance.	136
If, after discussions, the veterinarian so agrees, the	137
veterinarian shall prepare, sign, and deliver to the board a	138
letter of intent stipulating the agreed to terms.	139
(D) If the veterinarian does not prepare, sign, and	140
deliver the letter of intent to the board within thirty days of	141
receiving notice under division (C) of this section, the	142
veterinarian forfeits their acceptance into the program and the	143
board shall select another veterinarian for participation in the	144
program.	145
Sec. 4741.54. (A) After signing a letter of intent under	146
section 4741.53 of the Revised Code, a veterinarian and the	147
state veterinary medical licensing board may enter into a	148
contract for the veterinarian's participation in the veterinary	149
student debt assistance program. A lending institution also may	150
be a party to the contract.	151
(B) The contract shall include all of the following	152
obligations:	153
(1) The veterinarian agrees to perform charitable	154
veterinarian services in this state in a manner and for a time	155
and duration specified in the contract.	156
(2) The veterinarian agrees to continue to reside in this	157
state for a duration of time specified in the contract.	158

(3) The board agrees to repay, so long as the veterinarian	159
performs the obligations agreed to under divisions (B)(1) and	160
(2) of this section, all or part of an educational loan taken by	161
the veterinarian in an amount and under terms specified in the	162
contract.	163
(4) The veterinarian agrees to pay the board damages in an	164
amount specified in the contract, up to the amount the board	165
awarded the veterinarian, if the veterinarian fails to complete	166
the obligations agreed to under divisions (B)(1) and (2) of this	167
section.	168
(5) An assignment to the board of the veterinarian's duty	169
to pay the principal and interest of a government or other	170
educational loan taken by the veterinarian for expenses	171
described in section 4741.50 of the Revised Code;	172
(6) The terms of the assignment under division (B)(5) of	173
this section, which shall set forth the total amount of	174
principal and interest to be paid, an amortization schedule, and	175
the amount of each payment to be made under the schedule.	176
(C) The contract may include any other terms agreed to by	177
the parties.	178
(D) Not later than the thirty-first day of January each	179
year, the board shall mail to each veterinarian to whom or on	180
whose behalf veterinary student debt assistance is provided a	181
statement showing the amount of principal and interest repaid by	182
the board in the preceding year pursuant to the contract. The	183
board shall send the statement by ordinary mail with address	184
correction and forwarding requested in the manner prescribed by	185
the United States postal service.	186
(E) The board shall deposit money collected from damages	187

under division (B)(4) of this section into the veterinary	188
student debt assistance fund created in section 4741.56 of the	189
Revised Code.	190
Sec. 4741.55. (A) The state veterinary medical licensing	191
board shall post the following information regarding the	192
veterinary student debt assistance program on the board's web	193
<pre>site:</pre>	194
(1) The total number of veterinarians who applied to	195
participate in the program within the prior twelve months;	196
(2) The total amount of money awarded to program	197
participants within the prior twelve months;	198
(3) Any other information the board determines to be	199
pertinent.	200
(B) The board shall post the information specified in	201
division (A) of this section annually after the conclusion of	202
entering into contracts with program participants under section	203
4741.54 of the Revised Code for the applicable calendar year.	204
Sec. 4741.56. (A) There is hereby created the veterinary	205
student debt assistance fund in the state treasury to be used by	206
the state veterinary medical licensing board for the	207
implementation and administration of sections 4741.50 to 4741.57	208
of the Revised Code.	209
(B) The fund shall consist of all of the following:	210
(1) Money transferred into the fund from the occupational	211
licensing and regulatory fund in accordance with section 4743.05	212
of the Revised Code;	213
(2) Money received from gifts, donations, and beguests;	214

(3) Damages collected from program participants who fail	215
to fulfill their service obligations;	216
(4) Any other money contributed to the fund.	217
Sec. 4741.57. (A) As used in this section, "veterinarian	218
licenses and registrations" means all of the following issued	219
under section 4741.17 of the Revised Code:	220
(1) An initial veterinary license;	221
(2) An initial limited license to practice veterinary	222
medicine for an intern, resident in a veterinary specialty, or	223
<pre>graduate student;</pre>	224
(3) An initial limited license to practice veterinary	225
medicine for an instructor, researcher, or diagnostician;	226
(4) A veterinary temporary permit;	227
(5) A duplicate license;	228
(6) A renewal of a veterinary license;	229
(7) A renewal of a limited license to practice veterinary	230
<pre>medicine;</pre>	231
(8) An initial registered veterinary technician	232
<pre>registration;</pre>	233
(9) A renewal of a registered veterinary technician	234
<pre>registration;</pre>	235
(10) A specialist certificate;	236
(11) The reinstatement of a suspended or lapsed license;	237
(12) A provisional veterinary graduate license.	238
(B) Beginning July 1, 2020, and every two years	239

thereafter, the board shall certify to the director of budget	240
and management an amount equal to the amount received for	241
issuing veterinarian licenses and registrations during the	242
preceding fiscal year minus both of the following:	243
(1) The amount deposited into the veterinarian loan	244
repayment fund created in section 4741.46 of the Revised Code in	245
that fiscal year;	246
(2) The amount appropriated to the board from the	247
occupational licensing and regulatory fund in that fiscal year.	248
Sec. 4743.05. (A) Except as otherwise provided in sections	249
4701.20, 4723.062, 4723.082, 4729.65, 4781.121, and 4781.28 of	250
the Revised Code, all money collected under Chapters 3773.,	251
4701., 4703., 4709., 4713., 4715., 4717., 4723., 4725., 4729.,	252
4732., 4733., 4734., 4736., 4741., 4744., 4747., 4753., 4755.,	253
4757., 4758., 4771., 4775., 4779., and 4781. of the Revised Code	254
shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit of the	255
occupational licensing and regulatory fund, which is hereby	256
created for use in administering such chapters.	257
(B) At the end of each quarter, the director of budget and	258
management shall transfer from the occupational licensing and	259
regulatory fund to the nurse education assistance fund created	260
in section 3333.28 of the Revised Code the amount certified to	261
the director under division (B) of section 4723.08 of the	262
Revised Code.	263
(C) At the end of each quarter, the director shall	264
transfer from the occupational licensing and regulatory fund to	265
the certified public accountant education assistance fund	266
created in section 4701.26 of the Revised Code the amount	267
certified to the director under division (H)(2) of section	268

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4701.10 of the Revised Code.	269
(D) On July 30, 2020, and every two years thereafter, the	270
director shall transfer from the occupational licensing and	271
regulatory fund to the veterinary student debt assistance fund	272
created in section 4741.56 of the Revised Code the amount	273
certified to the director under section 4741.57 of the Revised	274
Code.	275
Section 2. That existing section 4743.05 of the Revised	276
Code is hereby repealed.	277
