a petition for a local option election authorizing the sale of
beer, wine, mixed beverages, or spirituous liquor on Sundays
that has been filed with a board of elections under section
4301.33, 4301.332, 4301.333, or 4301.334 of the Revised Code, as
amended by this act.

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(B) On the effective date of this act, if a board of
elections is in the process of reviewing a petition calling for
the submission of a question or questions authorizing Sunday
sales of beer, wine, mixed beverages, or spirituous liquor on
the ballot of the next general election or a special election
conducted on the day of the next primary election, the board
shall do either of the following, as applicable:

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(1) If ballots have not been printed, remove the question 19
or questions submitted to the board for placement on the ballot 20
of the next general election or a special election conducted on 21
the day of the next primary election; 22

(2) If ballots have been printed with the question or 23
questions on them, post a notice at each polling place on the 24
day of the election, and enclose with each absent voter's ballot 25
given or mailed after the question or questions are to be 26
removed, a notice that votes for the removed question or 27
questions will be void and will not be counted. If the question 28
or questions are not removed from all ballots before the day of 29
the election, the votes for the removed question or questions 30
are void and shall not be counted." 31
