605 SYNOPSIS

606 **Sunday sales of alcohol**

607 **R.C. 4303.182 and conforming changes**

608 Retains the prohibition against sales on Sunday at a particular location or in part or all of
609 a precinct if the voters had previously voted "no" on the sale in the 10 years prior to the bill's
610 effective date.

611 Provides a mechanism by which the voters may subsequently authorize such Sunday
612 sales for a particular location or part or all of a precinct.

613 Specifies that once Sunday sales are so authorized, no vote on Sunday sales may
614 subsequently occur regarding the particular location or precinct.
