"Sec. 117.116. The auditor of state, upon receiving 11  
notification that a county auditor has filed a warrant under 12  
protest as specified in section 319.16 of the Revised Code, may 13  
review that warrant as part of the auditor of state's next 14  
regularly scheduled audit of the public office that presented 15  
documents under that section that led to issuance of the warrant 16  
under protest. 17

**Sec. 319.16.** (A) The county auditor shall issue warrants, 18  
including electronic warrants authorizing direct deposit for 19  
payment of county obligations in accordance with division (F) of 20  
section 9.37 of the Revised Code, on the county treasurer for all 21  
moneys payable from the county treasury, upon presentation of 22  
either of the following: 23

(1) Any proper order or voucher and evidentiary matter for 24  
~~the moneys, and;~~ 25

(2) Any proper court order for expenses of any court funded 26  
through the county treasury and, upon request of the county 27  
auditor, legible copies of any court-approved invoice, bill, 28  
receipt, check, or contract related to the order, redacted as 29  
required by law, to the extent those documents exist. 30

(B) When a court order described in division (A)(2) of this 31  
section is presented, the auditor shall have no liability for that 32  
expenditure. The county auditor shall keep a record of all such 33  
warrants showing the number, date of issue, amount for which 34  
drawn, in whose favor, for what purpose, and on what fund. ~~The~~ 35

(C) The auditor shall not issue a warrant for the payment of 36  
any claim against the county, unless it is allowed by the board of 37  
county commissioners, except where the amount due is fixed by law 38  
or is allowed by an officer or tribunal, including a county board 39  
of mental health or county board of developmental disabilities, so 40  
authorized by law. ~~If~~ 41

(D) If the auditor questions the validity of an expenditure 42  
under division (A)(2) of this section that is within available 43  
appropriations and for which a proper order or voucher and 44  
~~evidentiary matter is presented,~~ the auditor shall notify the 45  
court that presented the documents, issue the warrant under 46

protest, and notify the auditor of state of the protest. When a 47  
warrant is issued under division (D) of this section, the auditor 48  
has no liability for that expenditure. If the auditor refuses to 49  
issue the warrant, a writ of mandamus may be sought. The court 50  
shall issue a writ of mandamus for issuance of the warrant if the 51  
court determines that the claim is valid. 52

(E) If the auditor questions the validity of an expenditure 53  
presented under division (A)(1) of this section that is within 54  
available appropriations, the auditor shall notify the board, 55  
officer, or tribunal who presented the ~~voucher~~ documents. 56  
If the board, officer, or tribunal determines that the expenditure is 57  
valid and the auditor ~~continues to refuse~~ refuses to issue the 58  
appropriate warrant on the county treasury, a writ of mandamus may 59  
be sought. The court shall issue a writ of mandamus for issuance 60  
of the warrant if the court determines that the claim is valid. 61

Evidentiary matter includes original invoices, receipts, 62  
bills and checks, and legible copies of contracts." 63

SYNOPSIS

**Warrants for county obligations** 67

**R.C. 117.116 and 319.16** 68

Requires the county auditor to issue warrants for payment of 69  
county obligations on the county treasurer for moneys paid out of 70

the county treasury upon presentation of a proper court order for 71  
expenses of any court funded through the county treasury. 72

Allows the county auditor to issue a warrant for payment 73  
under protest if the county auditor questions the validity of a 74  
court order for expenses submitted under this provision and allows 75  
the auditor of state to review a warrant filed in protest as part 76  
of the auditor's next regularly scheduled audit of the public 77  
office that presented the documents that led to issuance of the 78  
warrant under protest. 79
