SYNOPSIS 20

**Definition of indigent** 21

**R.C. 4510.10** 22

Changes the definition of "indigent" in the bill to mean a 23  
person who participates in one of the following programs: 24

1. The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP); 25

2. The Medicaid Program; 26

3. The Ohio Works First Program; 27

4. The Supplemental Security Income Program; or 28

5. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Pension Benefit 29  
Program. 30

(The revised definition is consistent with the definition 31  
of "indigent" established by H.B. 285, which creates the 32  
permanent Driver's License Reinstatement Fee Debt Reduction and 33  
Amnesty Program. The bill currently defines "indigent person" as 34  
a person who qualifies for public defender representation.) 35
