As Passed by the Senate

_____ moved to amend as follows:

"Sec. 4507.112. (A) Notwithstanding section 4507.11 of the 10
Revised Code, the director of public safety may adopt rules in 11
accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code authorizing a 12
third party to administer the motor vehicle skills test required 13
to obtain a driver's license. The skills test administered by a 14
third party under this section shall be the same as otherwise 15
would be administered by the bureau of motor vehicles. 16

(B) Any third party authorized to administer the driver's 17



license skills test shall enter into an agreement with the 18
director that does all of the following: 19

(1) Allows the director or the director's representative 20
to conduct random examinations, inspections, and audits of the 21
third party, whether covert or overt, without prior notice; 22

(2) Requires all examiners of the third party to meet the 23
same qualification and training standards as examiners of the 24
department of public safety; 25

(3) Requires the third party to use designated road test 26
routes that have been approved by the director; 27

(4) If the third party also is a driver training school, 28
prohibits a skills test examiner employed by the school from 29
administering a skills test to an applicant that the examiner 30
personally trained; 31

(5) Establishes appropriate documentation and 32
communication between the third party and the department 33
indicating who has attempted the skills test with the third 34
party and whether the person completed the test successfully; 35

(6) Reserves to the department the right to take prompt 36
and appropriate remedial action against the third party and its 37
skills test examiners if the third party or its skills test 38
examiners fail to comply with standards of this state for the 39
testing program or with any other terms of the contract." 40
