

To whom it may concern, my name is Jason Neuhard. I am a father of five children aged four to fifteen. My fifteen year old son attends Grove City Christian thanks to an ED choice scholarship. We live in the hilltop area on the west side of Columbus. Thankfully we were able to take advantage of the ED Choice program because the school my son would normally be attending has been in decline for the past few years. My wife has recently started a great job at AB-Inbev and our financial situation has improved. My family used to receive food assistance and medic aide. We no longer qualify because we are not within the 130% of the poverty level, so when I read about possible changes to ED Choice, I have many concerns. Changes to ED Choice would affect my entire family. If my other four children are not able to have the same opportunity that ED Choice provided for my son, my family and I will be moving out of the Columbus City School district. I refuse to send my children to a failing school due to changes determined by stake holders.
