Lee Davis has served in multiple leadership roles in the wholesale generation industry during a career spanning more than 25 years. His background in engineering combined with his business acumen and management style have enabled Lee to become a trusted leader in the energy industry.

Lee has served as Chief Executive Officer of Kindle Energy since its formation in 2015. Kindle Energy has a dual focus of providing asset management services while also acquiring, developing, and optimizing power generation assets throughout North America.

Prior to his current role at Kindle Energy, Lee served in various roles of increasing management responsibility at NRG Energy, Inc. ("NRG"). Lee began as Director Northeast Asset Management and Development, and advanced to Executive Vice President and Regional President of NRG's largest region, the East Region. Under Lee's leadership and direction, the East Region expanded from a portfolio of over 7 GW to over 26 GW throughout nine states and three power markets, resulting from the mergers with both GenOn Energy, Inc. in 2012 and Edison Mission Energy in 2014. Lee was instrumental in leading the successful transition and integration of the GenOn and Midwest Generation portfolios into NRG. He led NRG's efforts to maximize the value of existing units, repower generating sites with more efficient units, reduce fossil fuel emissions, and build new cleaner energy resources in PJM, MISO, and ISO-NE.

Lee's industry experience also includes Mirant Corporation and Calpine.

Lee holds an MBA from Emory University and a bachelor's degree of Electrical Engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology.
