Dear Chairman Vitale:

On behalf of The Dayton Power and Light Company, I am writing regarding today's adoption of substitute HB 6, (I\_133\_0905-17) by the House Energy & Natural Resources Committee. This version positively addresses a broader group of energy issues and reduces DP&L residential customer monthly payments. Additions and changes since the as-introduced version include:

- The ability to complete DP&L's current energy efficiency portfolio plan, running through 2020.
- Permitting DP&L to apply to the PUCO for new energy efficiency programs approved and overseen by the Commission.
- Reducing the monthly residential charge compared to DP&L's current energy efficiency/peak demand charge.
- Codifying DP&L's current, PUCO approved recovery of the OVEC national security generation resource and extending it through 2030.

We appreciate the Energy & Natural Resource Committee's willingness to work through multiple versions of HB 6 and anticipate that conversations will continue as we prepare our state for emerging energy technologies and innovations.
