Representative Crossman moved to amend House Bill 38 (1533). Representative Hillyer 2nd the motion. The motion was agreed to without objection.

Representative Hillyer moved to amend House Bill 38 (1516X2). Representative Lang 2nd the motion. An objection was made by Representative Crossman and the roll was taken. The motion was agreed to by a vote of 10-5.

The Chair inquired on the pleasure of the committee. Representative Hillyer moved that the Financial Institutions Committee favorably report House Bill 38 to the House Rules and Reference Committee. Representative Roemer 2nd the motion. The Chair called the roll. House Bill 38 was favorably reported with a vote of 15 yeas and 0 nays.

Chair Jordan called up House Bill 131 for its 5th hearing.

Representative Roemer moved to accept a substitute bill for House Bill 131 (2081-1). Representative Carfagna 2nd the motion. The motion was agreed to without objection.

Chair Jordan called up House Bill 150 for its 6th hearing.

Representative Merrin moved to amend House Bill 150 (1539). Representative Hillyer 2nd the
