"Sec. 101.36. The general assembly, in each fiscal year, shall appropriate from the general revenue fund to the mandatory motherhood remediation fund created in section 101.361 of the Revised Code an amount equal to the amount it appropriates, or is allocated or expended, in that fiscal year to defend S.B. 23 of the 133rd general assembly. 8

Sec. 101.361. There is hereby created the mandatory motherhood remediation fund, which shall be in the custody of the treasurer of state but shall not be a part of the state treasury. The fund shall be comprised of amounts appropriated under section 101.36 of the Revised Code. The money in the fund shall be used by the department of health to fund initiatives and programs that 14

improve maternal mortality outcomes in Ohio. The treasurer of 20  
state shall disburse money from the fund on order of the 21  
department of health. Any interest earned by the fund shall be 22  
credited to the fund. 23

**Sec. 109.96.** (A) The attorney general shall track both of the 24  
following with respect to legal counsel employed in defending S.B. 25  
23 of the 133rd general assembly: 26

(1) The hourly billing rate and the number of hours billed by 27  
special counsel; 28

(2) The number of hours spent by assistant attorneys general, 29  
at a billing rate of two hundred dollars per hour. 30

(B) The data tracked under this section shall be used to 31  
assist in determining the amount to be appropriated under section 32  
101.36 of the Revised Code. 33

(C) The hours tracked under division (A)(2) of this section 34  
shall be reported to the treasurer of state, the director of 35  
health, and the general assembly." 36
