Topic: Child care and transportation vouchers; pregnant woman support

"Sec. 5101.51. Upon determining the paternity of a child a 9
pregnant woman is carrying, the man determined to be the father of 10
the child shall immediately be subject to pregnant woman support 11
in accordance with the rules adopted by the department of job and 12
family services." 13

Sec. 5101.52. The department of job and family services shall 14
adopt rules to create the pregnant woman support program to 15
provide financial support to women who are pregnant." 16

After line 1497, insert: 17

"Sec. 5101.44. (A) There is hereby created in the department 18
of job and family services a child care voucher program. Under the 19
program, the department shall provide eligible women with vouchers 20
to purchase child care from any child day-care center 21
participating in the step up to quality program established under 22
section 5104.29 of the Revised Code. The department shall provide 23
the vouchers to each eligible woman for all of her children who 24
are under six years of age. Centers may present these vouchers to 25
the department for payment in accordance with rules adopted under 26
this section. The value of each voucher shall be the lower of the 27
rate customarily charged by the center or the rate the center 28
would be paid for providing publicly funded child care pursuant to 29
a contract under section 5104.32 of the Revised Code. 30

(B) The director of job and family services shall adopt rules 31
in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code to implement 32
this section. The rules shall specify eligibility requirements for 33
the program, including that recipients of publicly funded child 34
care under section 5104.34 of the Revised Code are not eligible to 35
participate in the program. 36

Sec. 5501.35. (A) There is hereby created in the department 37
of transportation the public transportation voucher program. Under 38
the program, the department shall provide eligible women with 39
public transportation vouchers. 40

(B)(1) Eligible women may use the public transportation 41
vouchers provided under the program for transportation to and from 42
any of the following locations: 43

(a) A person that provides child care to the woman's 44
children; 45

(b) A school or employment training program in which the 46

woman is enrolled; 47

(c) The woman's place of employment; 48

(d) A person that provides postnatal health care to the woman
or health care to the woman's children. 49
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(2) Public transportation providers may present these
vouchers to the department for payment in accordance with rules
adopted under this section. 51
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(C) The director of transportation shall adopt rules in
accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code to implement this
section. The rules shall specify eligibility requirements for
participating in the program." 54

"**Section 3.** All items in this section are hereby appropriated 59
as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the 60
credit of the designated fund. The appropriations made in this act 61
are in addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 62
2020-FY 2021 biennium. 63

CHILD CARE STATE/MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT 64

On the effective date of this section, or as soon as possible 65
thereafter, the Director of Job and Family Services shall certify 66
to the Director of Budget and Management the cost of providing 67
child care vouchers to eligible women pursuant to section 5104.44 68
of the Revised Code in fiscal year 2020 and fiscal year 2021. The 69
amounts certified are hereby appropriated to appropriation item 70
600413, Child Care State/Maintenance of Effort. 71

HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION - STATE 72

On the effective date of this section, or as soon as possible 73

thereafter, the Director of Transportation shall certify to the 74
 Director of Budget and Management the cost of providing public 75
 transportation vouchers to women eligible for the program 76
 described in section 5501.35 of the Revised Code in fiscal year 77
 2020 and fiscal year 2021. The amount certified is hereby 78
 appropriated to appropriation item 772421, Highway Construction - 79
 State. 80

Section 4. Within the limits set forth in this act, the 81
 Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 82
 indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 83
 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in which 84
 appropriation accounts shall be maintained. 85

Expenditures from appropriation item 600413, Child Care 86
 State/Maintenance of Effort, shall be accounted for as though made 87
 in the main operating appropriations act of the 133rd General 88
 Assembly. This appropriation made in this act is subject to all 89
 provisions of the main operating appropriations act of the 133rd 90
 General Assembly that are generally applicable to such 91
 appropriations. 92

Expenditures from appropriation item 772421, Highway 93
 Construction - State shall be accounted for as through made in Am. 94
 Sub. H.B. 62 of the 133rd General Assembly. This appropriation 95
 made in this act is subject to all of the provisions of Am. Sub. 96
 H.B. 62 of the 133rd General Assembly that are generally 97
 applicable to such appropriations." 98
