

House Health Committee

June 2nd, 2020 – Minutes

Chairman Lipps called the meeting of the House Health Committee to order at 11:08 AM on June 2nd, 2020. The roll was called; a quorum was present; the committee proceeded as a full committee.

The minutes from the committee hearing held on May 19th, 2020 were read and approved without objection.

Chairman Lipps called Am. SB 59 up for its fourth hearing. Only written testimony was provided. Representative Ginter moved the Am. SB 59 be favorably reported to the House Rules and Reference Committee. With 15 affirmative votes the bill passed.

Chairman Lipps called House Bill 484 up for its third hearing. Representative Carfagna provided a summary of the amendment AM133 2423-1 and answered the committee's questions. Chairman Lipps moved to accept the amendment. Representative Ginter seconded the motion and the amendment was accepted without objection.

After questions, the first hearing on HB484 was concluded.

Chairman Lipps called House Bill 469 up for its second hearing. Testimony was provided by:

Chairman Lipps called Senate Bill 178 up for its first hearing. Testimony was provided by:
