**Referral Report**

**April 2, 2019**

Representative Sykes reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills and Senate Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

**H. B. No. 163 – Representative Brinkman**

To create a process for withholding local government funds and state water and sewer assistance from municipal corporations that engage in certain water and sewer practices with respect to extraterritorial service.

**To the committee on Public Utilities**

**H. B. No. 165 – Representatives Liston, Galonski**

Regarding the adoption of health education standards.

**To the committee on Primary and Secondary Education**

**H. B. No. 167 – Representative Cera**

To modify workers' compensation benefit amounts for occupational pneumoconiosis claims and to create the Occupational Pneumoconiosis Board to determine medical findings for such claims.

**To the committee on Commerce and Labor**

**H. B. No. 168 – Representative Arndt**

To establish an affirmative defense to a release or threatened release of hazardous substances from a facility for certain bona fide prospective purchasers.

**To the committee on Civil Justice**

**H. B. No. 169 – Representatives Keller, Antani**

To require state and local authorities to cooperate with the federal government in the enforcement of immigration laws, to sanction those that fail to do so, and to declare an emergency.

To require the Treasurer of State to administer the Pay for Success Contracting Program and to expand the purposes of the Program.

To exempt from sales and use tax things used primarily to move completed manufactured products or general merchandise.

To require certain convention and visitors' bureaus to make available for inspection by the public all meeting minutes, vendor payment information, and financial information.

**H. B. No. 177 – Representative Brinkman**

Regarding standard care arrangements entered into by advanced practice registered nurses and collaborating physicians or podiatrists; physician prescribing of schedule II controlled substances from convenience care clinics; and clearances by licensed health professionals of concussed student athletes.

To make a capital appropriation for school facilities assistance.
