### Referral Report

**April 16, 2019**

Representative Sykes reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills and Senate Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

**H. B. No. 6 – Representatives Callender, Wilkin**

To create the Ohio Clean Air Program, to facilitate and encourage electricity production and use from clean air resources, to facilitate investment to reduce the emissions from other generating technologies that can be readily dispatched to satisfy demand in real time, and proactively engage the buying power of consumers in this state for the purpose of improving air quality in this state.

**To the committee on Energy and Natural Resources**

**H. B. No. 196 – Representative Powell**

To exempt from sales tax memberships to gyms or other recreational facilities operated by nonprofit 501(c)(3) organizations.

**To the committee on Ways and Means**

**H. B. No. 197 – Representatives Powell, Merrin**

To enact the "Tax Code Streamlining and Correction Act" to make technical and corrective changes to the laws governing taxation.

**Sub. S. B. No. 8 – Senator Schuring**

To authorize a tax credit for investments in an Ohio Opportunity Zone.

**To the committee on Economic and Workforce Development**

**Am. S. B. No. 24 – Senators Wilson, Yuko**

To establish the Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias Task Force.

**Sub. S. B. No. 31 – Senator Roegner**

To include emergency service telecommunicators and certain Ohio National Guard members as individuals whose residential and familial information is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Law.

**S. B. No. 48 – Senator Eklund**

To narrow the scope of speedy trial rules.

To create the civilian cyber security reserve forces, to make the Secretary of State a member of the Homeland Security Advisory Council, to require the Secretary of State to appoint a chief information security officer, to require the boards of elections to audit election results, and to make an appropriation.
