**Referral Report**

**May 21, 2019**

Representative Boggs reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

**H. B. No. 3 – Representatives Boyd, Carruthers**

To add domestic violence circumstances to the offenses of aggravated murder and endangering children, to establish local domestic violence high risk teams, and to require law enforcement officers to utilize a qualified lethality assessment screening tool to refer high risk victims to a local team.

**To the committee on Criminal Justice**

**H. B. No. 4 – Representatives Richardson, Robinson**

To permit the Governor's Office of Workforce Transformation to develop industry-recognized credentials and certificate programs.

**To the committee on Economic and Workforce Development**

**H. B. No. 10 – Representatives Brown, Stoltzfus**

To establish the Governor's Office of Drug Policy and to make an appropriation.

**To the committee on Health**

**H. B. No. 11 – Representatives Manning, G., Howse**

Regarding tobacco cessation and prenatal initiatives and to make an appropriation.

**H. B. No. 13 – Representatives Carfagna, O'Brien**

To establish the residential broadband expansion program and to make an appropriation.

**H. B. No. 242 – Representatives Lang, Jones**

To authorize the use of an auxiliary container for any purpose, to prohibit the imposition of a tax or fee on those containers, and to apply existing anti-littering law to those containers.

To require health plan issuers to cover hearing aids and related services for persons under twenty-two years of age.
