Representative Sykes reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

H. B. No. 277 – Representatives Plummer, West

To revise the law governing the electronic recording of custodial interrogations.

To the committee on Criminal Justice

H. B. No. 278 – Representative Jones

To designate a portion of State Route 800 in Belmont County as the "Steven Lowell Cook Memorial Highway."

To the committee on Transportation and Public Safety

H. B. No. 279 – Representatives Boggs, Galonski

To eliminate the spousal exceptions for certain sex offenses, to permit a person to testify against the person's spouse in a prosecution for any of those offenses, to eliminate the period of limitation for the criminal prosecution of a person for rape and for a civil action brought by a victim of conduct that would constitute rape, and to amend the versions of sections 2907.02 and 2907.05 of the Revised Code that are scheduled to take effect March 22, 2020, to continue the provisions of this act on and after that effective date.
