**Rules Report**

The House Rules and Reference committee met on Tuesday, October 1, 2019, at 12:00 p.m.

The following matters, being properly before the committee and pursuant to House Rule 66, were scheduled for third consideration on the House calendar in the order indicated below for the date indicated below.

Wednesday, October 2, 2019

**Sub. S. B. No. 52 Gavarone, et al.** – To create the civilian cyber security reserve forces, to make the Secretary of State a member of the Homeland Security Advisory Council, to require the Secretary of State to appoint a chief information security officer, to require the boards of elections to audit election results, and to make an appropriation.

**Am. H. B. No. 46 Greenspan, et al.** – To require the Treasurer of State to establish the Ohio State Government Expenditure Database.

**Sub. H. B. No. 123 (Holmes, G., Manning, G.)** – To enact the "Safety and Violence Education Students (SAVE Students) Act" regarding school security and youth suicide awareness education and training.

**H. B. No. 158 Blessing, et al.** – To waive the fee for filing a petition for limited driving privileges for an individual who qualifies as indigent and whose license is suspended as a result of failure to maintain proof of financial responsibility, and to authorize a court to grant such limited driving privileges on a first offense.

**H. B. No. 160 Ingram, et al.** – To revise the law governing alcoholic ice cream.
