Representative Boggs reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

H. B. No. 382 – Representative Jordan

To prohibit municipal corporations from levying an income tax on nonresidents' compensation for personal services or on net profits from a sole proprietorship owned by a nonresident.

H. B. No. 383 – Representative Clites

To designate March as "Bleeding Disorders Awareness Month."
