Representative Sykes reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

**H. B. No. 439 – Representative Stephens**

To adjust for inflation the \$25,000 homestead exemption and the enhanced homestead exemption for disabled veterans.

**To the committee on Ways and Means**

**H. B. No. 440 – Representatives Miranda, Carruthers**

To authorize sales tax exemptions for property and services used to clean or maintain manufacturing machinery and for employment services used to operate manufacturing machinery.
