The following matters, being properly before the committee and pursuant to House Rule 66, were scheduled for third consideration on the House calendar in the order indicated below for the date indicated below.

Thursday, May 28, 2020

Sub. H. B. No. 282 Holmes, A., LaRe, et al. – To allow charitable organizations to conduct electronic instant bingo and to make other changes to the law governing bingo.

H. B. No. 194 Greenspan, Kelly – To create a Sports Gaming Advisory Board, to legalize and regulate sports gaming in this state, and to levy a tax on businesses that provide sports gaming.

H. B. No. 431 Abrams, Carfagna, et al. – To create the Sexual Exploitation Database and to make an appropriation.

No. 606 Grendell, et al. – To grant civil immunity to a person who provides services for essential businesses and operations for injury, death, or loss that was caused by the transmission of COVID-19 during the period of emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March 9, 2020, and to declare an emergency.
