(A) As soon as practicable after October 5, 2020, each board of elections shall mail absent voter's ballots for the November 3, 2020, general election to every registered elector in the county who has not already been sent those ballots. The board shall continue to accept applications for absent voter's ballots in accordance with Title XXXV of the Revised Code. 7

(B) If the procedures described in division (B) of section 3501.19 of the Revised Code, as enacted by this act, are not used for the November 3, 2020, general election, an elector appears to vote in person, and the board of elections has not received an envelope purporting to contain absent voter's ballots cast by that elector, the elector shall be eligible to 13
