ballots are to be voted, whichever is earlier, and not later 15
than twelve noon on the tenth day before the day of the election 16

After line 176, insert:

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"Sec. 3509.031. (A) The secretary of state shall establish a secure online system for electors to apply for absent voter's ballots. The system shall provide for all of the following:

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(1) An elector to submit an application online through the internet to vote in an election by absent voter's ballots. The system shall permit the elector to submit the application not earlier than the first day of January of the year of the election or not earlier than ninety days before the day of the election, whichever is earlier.

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(2) The secretary of state to transmit the completed application to the board of elections of the county in which the elector resides;

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(3) The elector to be sent proper absent voter's ballots for the applicable election in accordance with section 3509.04 of the Revised Code, if all of the following apply:

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(a) The application contains all of the information required under section 3509.03 of the Revised Code.

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(b) The elector is registered to vote and eligible to vote in the election for which the elector is seeking absent voter's ballots.

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(c) The elector attests to the truth and accuracy of the information submitted in the online application under penalty of election falsification using the elector's birth date and the elector's Ohio driver's license number, the elector's Ohio identification card number, or the last four digits of the elector's social security number as proof of the elector's identity.

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(d) The elector submits the application through the online system not later than twelve noon on the third day before the day of the election at which the ballots are to be voted. 46
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(B) If an elector applies to vote by absent voter's ballots under this section, the secretary of state shall obtain an electronic copy of the elector's signature that is on file with the statewide voter registration database. That electronic signature shall be used as the elector's signature on the absent voter's ballot application for the purpose of matching the signature with the elector's signature on the elector's voter registration record. 49
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(C) The secretary of state shall employ security measures necessary to ensure the integrity and accuracy of information submitted electronically pursuant to this section. Errors in processing applications for absent voter's ballots in the online system shall not prevent an elector from receiving absent voter's ballots." 57
