



Finance Subcommittee on Higher Education Minutes

Chair Carfagna called the meeting of the House Finance Subcommittee on Higher Education to order at 11:04am in Statehouse Room 311.

A quorum was present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved without objection.

Chair Carfagna began the Subcommittee's first hearing on House Bill 166, the Main Operating Budget for FY2020-FY2021, by calling Director Burt Logan of the Ohio History Connection forward to provide proponent testimony. Following his testimony, Director Logan answered questions asked by the committee members.

Chair Carfagna continued the hearing by calling forward Director Paul Nick of the Ohio Ethics Commission to provide proponent testimony. Following his testimony, Director Nick answered questions asked by the committee members.

Chair Carfagna continued the hearing by calling forward Director Donna Collins of the Ohio Arts Council to provide proponent testimony. Following her testimony, Director Collins answered questions asked by the committee members.

Chair Carfagna continued the hearing by calling forward Director Bill Behrendt of the Ohio Citizens for the Arts to provide proponent testimony. Following his testimony, Director Behrendt answered questions asked by the committee members.

At 12:50pm, the subcommittee recessed. At 2:25pm, the subcommittee reconvened in Statehouse Room 121.

The first hearing on House Bill 166 continued. Chair Carfagna called forward Director Beverly Cain of the State Library Board to provide proponent testimony. Chair Carfagna then called Director David Weaver of the Ohioana Library Association to offer proponent testimony. Following Director Weaver's testimony, Directors Cain and Weaver answered questions asked by the committee members.

This concluded the committee's first hearing on HB 166. With no further business before the committee, the committee adjourned at 3:09pm.
