



Finance Subcommittee on Higher Education Minutes

Chair Carfagna called the meeting of the House Finance Subcommittee on Higher Education to order at 9:03am in Statehouse Room 018.

Chair Carfagna continued the hearing by calling forward Jay Easterling, Chief Financial Officer in the Office of Attorney General Dave Yost, to provide proponent testimony on behalf of the Attorney General's Office. Following his testimony, Mr. Easterling answered questions asked by the committee members.

Chair Carfagna continued the hearing by calling Inspector General Randall Meyer to provide proponent testimony on behalf of the Office of the Inspector General. Following his testimony, Inspector General Meyer answered questions asked by the committee members.
