



**Finance Subcommittee on Higher Education Minutes**

Chair Carfagna called the meeting of the House Finance Subcommittee on Higher Education to order at 11:02am in Statehouse Room 018.

A quorum was present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved without objection.

Chair Carfagna began the Subcommittee's fourth hearing on House Bill 166, the Main Operating Budget for FY2020-FY2021, by calling Director Bernie Profato forward to provide proponent testimony on behalf of the Ohio Athletic Commission. Chair Carfagna continued the hearing by calling forward Director Laura Battocletti to provide proponent testimony on behalf of the Capitol Square Review and Advisor Board. Following her testimony, Director Battocletti answered questions asked by the committee members.

Chair Carfagna continued the hearing by calling Director Lilly Cavanaugh to provide proponent testimony on behalf of the Ohio Commission on Hispanic and Latino Affairs. Following her testimony, Director Cavanaugh answered questions asked by the committee members.

This concluded the committee's fourth hearing on HB 166. With no further business before the committee, the committee adjourned at 1:05pm.
