5534.818, 5534.822, 5534.823,"; after "5534.824" insert ", 12
5534.825, 5534.826, 5534.881, 5534.883, 5534.884, 5534.89, 13
5534.896, 5534.898, 5534.91, and 5534.913" 14

After line 7, insert: 15

"Sec. 5534.407. In addition to any other name prescribed by 16
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 17
of state route number two between the intersection of that route 18
and state route number three hundred six and the intersection of 19

that route and state route number six hundred fifteen, in Lake 20
county, shall be known as the "Patrolman Mathew Mazany Memorial 21
Highway." 22

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 23
along the highway indicating its name. 24

Sec. 5534.60. In addition to any other name prescribed in the 25
Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes of 26
United States route number sixty-two between Staunton-Sugar Grove 27
road and Greenfield Sabina road, in Fayette county, shall be known 28
as the "PFC William Boggs, CPL Sam Boggs, and SGT Robert Boggs 29
Memorial Highway." 30

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 31
along the highway indicating its name. 32

Sec. 5534.601. In addition to any other name prescribed in 33
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes 34
of state route number one hundred eight between the southern 35
border of Henry county and the northern border of Henry county 36
shall be known as the "RDML Alene Duerk Memorial Highway." 37

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 38
along the highway indicating its name. 39

Sec. 5534.602. In addition to any other name prescribed in 40
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes 41
of state route number sixty-six between Houston road and Roeth 42
road, in Shelby county, shall be known as the "SFC Charles Gregory 43
Huston Memorial Highway." 44

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 45
along the highway indicating its name. 46

Sec. 5534.752. The bridge spanning the Maumee river in Henry county and being a part of the highway known as state route one hundred nine shall be known as the "Damascus Bridge." 47
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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 50
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Sec. 5534.812. In addition to any other name prescribed in the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes of interstate route number four hundred seventy-five between hill avenue and state route number two, in Lucas county only, shall be known as the "SGT Alex Drabik Memorial Highway." 52
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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name. 57
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Sec. 5534.814. The bridge spanning Grand river that is a part of Fairport road and that is a primary entrance and exit to Fairport Harbor, in Lake county, shall be known as the "Col. Donald Blakeslee Memorial Bridge." 59
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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 63
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Sec. 5534.818. In addition to any other name prescribed in the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as state route number one hundred fifty-two, running in a northerly and southerly direction between the intersection of that route with county road fifty-six and the intersection of that route with township road two hundred forty-nine, in Jefferson county only, shall be known as the "PFC George Dennis McClelland Memorial Highway." 65
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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 73

along the highway indicating its name.

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Sec. 5534.822. In addition to any other name prescribed by the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes of interstate route number seventy-one between mile marker twenty-two and mile marker twenty-three in Warren county shall be known as the "Veterans Suicide Memorial Mile."

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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

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Sec. 5534.823. In addition to any other name prescribed by the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes of state route number one hundred twenty-five, between mile marker four and mile marker five, in Brown county only, shall be known as the "PFC M. Preston Wheeler Memorial Highway."

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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name."

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After line 17, insert:

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"Sec. 5534.825. In addition to any other name prescribed in the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes of state route number twenty-five between the intersection of that route and United States route number twenty and the intersection of that route and United States route number twenty-three, in Wood county only, shall be known as the "SGT Arthur A. Mora, Jr. Memorial Highway."

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The director of transportation may erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

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Sec. 5534.826. In addition to any other name prescribed in

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the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 100
of United States route number thirty-six between the intersection 101
of that route and the western border of Coshocton county and the 102
intersection of that route and state route number seventy-nine, in 103
Coshocton county only, shall be known as the "Charles C. Nichols 104
Memorial Highway." 105

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 106
along the highway indicating its name. 107

Sec. 5534.881. In addition to any other name prescribed in 108
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes 109
of state route number ninety-nine between the intersection of that 110
route and county road number sixty-four and the intersection of 111
that route and county road number one hundred nineteen, in Huron 112
county, shall be known as the "Lance Corporal James Sprowl 113
Memorial Highway." 114

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 115
along the highway indicating its name. 116

Sec. 5534.883. In addition to any other name prescribed in 117
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes 118
of United States route number twenty-three between mile marker six 119
and mile marker eight, within Ross county, shall be known as the 120
"SGT Michael Keith Hamner Memorial Highway." 121

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 122
along the highway indicating its name. 123

Sec. 5534.884. In addition to any other name prescribed in 124
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes 125
of state route number sixty-five between county road H and state 126

route number one hundred ten, in Henry county, shall be known as 127
the "LTC Kevin Sonnenberg Memorial Highway." 128

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 129
along the highway indicating its name. 130

Sec. 5534.89. (A) In addition to any other name prescribed in 131
the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of the road known as 132
state route number fifty-three, commencing at the intersection of 133
that route and water street and proceeding in a southerly 134
direction to the Catawba island township line in Ottawa county 135
shall be known as the "Catawba Island Township Veterans Memorial 136
Highway." 137

(B) The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 138
along the highway indicating its name. 139

(C) Subject to approval by the director in relation to the 140
marker size, color, format, and method of placement, the Catawba 141
island township board of trustees may erect auxiliary markers in 142
conjunction with the markers erected by the director under 143
division (B) of this section, displaying the following names and 144
any other name of a United States military veteran approved by the 145
board: 146

(1) Private First Class William E. Galloway; 147

(2) SP4 James M. Davenport. 148

Sec. 5534.896. The bridge that is part of state route number 149
six hundred three, located in the village of Plymouth in Huron and 150
Richland counties, and being a part of the road known as Trux 151
street, shall be known as the "Trucks Bridge." 152

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 153

upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 154

Sec. 5534.898. In addition to any other name prescribed by 155
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes 156
of state route number four between the intersection of that route 157
and Owens road west and the intersection of that route and 158
Somerlot Hoffman road west, in Marion county only, shall be known 159
as the "SGT David S. Harris Memorial Highway." 160

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 161
along the highway indicating its name. 162

Sec. 5534.91. In addition to any other name prescribed in the 163
Revised Code or otherwise, the southbound lane of interstate route 164
number seventy-one commencing at mile marker one hundred two and 165
continuing to mile marker one hundred, in Franklin county, shall 166
be known as the "James H. Hough Memorial Highway." 167

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 168
along the highway indicating its name. 169

Sec. 5534.913. In addition to any other name prescribed in 170
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes 171
of interstate route number two hundred seventy-one between South 172
Woodland road and Harvard road, in Cuyahoga county, shall be known 173
as the "Ronald H. Barron Memorial Highway." 174

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 175
along the highway indicating its name." 176
